EBCWA Diploma of Theology (Zambia Standard)

This is not a “western world” course. It grew out of the original Diploma Course developed in Te Papapa, New Zealand, for Polynesian Youth Ministry on the toughest streets of Auckland, and it has through revision become a battle tested course for the tough streets of Africa. It is a “born again believer’s only” course! It is a purely Biblical Course, and so if you are looking for a “UN Agenda 2030” friendly course, or “equal opportunities”, this is certainly not the one for you!

It is Biblical, not political, nor does it accommodate itself to any legislation of any nation. There is no connection to Government Legislation – that is deliberate – and that is our permanent position. With the apostles we affirm, there is neither cultural, social, racial, nor biological distinction to be made between any believers; we are one in Christ Jesus, and we speak only to the united Body of Christ, not to sectional interests, no matter how popular such divisive things are.

There is no discussions of gender identity, racial or cultural theories of any sort, no economic theories, nor political viewpoints. We stand in the Apostolic Faith, once delivered, and unchangeable – we are **captive to Scripture alone**, and we will not enter into any debates that are not biblical in source, and spiritually fruitful in their results. If the results of this course do not work out spiritually on the tough streets of African cities, we have failed in our mission!

To undertake African Mission you require a current Yellow Booklet, “The International Certificate of Vaccination”, with all the required vaccinations enabling you to travel freely, proving you are not a danger to local communities, and a danger to yourself and your church family on return. If you do not have this, or are not prepared to vaccinate – then don’t use this course.

If you need any “special” requirements, **do not do this!** This is a mission’s course, and if you need help, stay where you are, and get it, but do not go to a place where you are present to help, not be a burden to people who desperately need assistance! If you need counselling to succeed in study, begin when you no longer need it! If you need medications, fine, buy them yourself and ask for no assistance, for there won’t be any in mission situations. If you can’t eat certain foods, and have allergies or anxieties, please resolve them, or seek another path than the one this course leads to, for it leads to cities like Lusaka.
